



POOL AREA RULES

In order to use the community pool, homeowner dues must be paid in full. If dues are not paid, no one in the household may use the pool or be the guest of another homeowner whose dues are paid in full.

1. Hours: 8:00 AM 10:00 PM May through September. Pool is subject to closure at the Board of Directors' discretion
2. Pool use is for residents who are current with their dues and their guests only
3. A resident must accompany all guests
4. Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult, at least 18 years of age, at all times
5. Residents are responsible for any damage or disturbance created by themselves or their guests – No horseplay or loud roughness
6. No running
7. No diving
8. No pets
9. Swim suits and swim trunks are required – No cutoffs allowed
10. Rafts, floats, bogie boards allowed during the week; not allowed on weekend
11. Safety floatation devices for children are acceptable (life vests, arm floats)
12. Close umbrellas before leaving the pool area as winds can cause damage
13. Use pool furniture appropriately – No jumping on furniture
14. Life buoys and rescue poles are for emergency use only
15. No unauthorized parking – Vehicles parked overnight will be towed
16. Keep pool area clean – clean up before leaving
17. No glass or breakables in pool area
18. No smoking in pool area
19. Keep gate closed at all times – Do not allow unauthorized people to enter

20. Violation of any of the above rules may be subject to fines and loss of pool privileges
